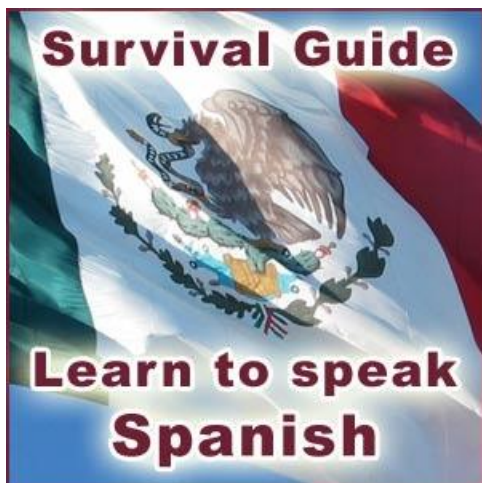

Advanced Survival Spanish



Course Description: This course builds on words, phrases, and cultural differences presented in Spanish for Criminal Justice Professionals. Review and emphasis on alert words that signal insults and dangerous situations. The student will speak and understand the words and phrases that will enable them to obtain identification, addresses, telephone numbers, drivers license, proof of insurance, and assist the injured. The student will also be able to control the arrest situation and advise an individual of their rights.
