Cross-over CMS Law Enforcement to Corrections Academy



Course Description: The Basic Crossover Academy from CMS Law Enforcement to Corrections prepares students as entry level Corrections officers in the State of Florida. **This program is for students who are certified as Law Enforcement Officers** and wish to continue with additional training to become certified as a Corrections officer. Practical skills and simulated activities compliment the classroom instruction. Upon successful completion, students are eligible to take the

Florida State Correction Officer Certification Examination. This minimum standards class is regulated by Florida statutes and is a highly structured and disciplined program with special rules, policies, and procedures. Admission Requirements: This is a Limited Access program and you **must** be a U.S. citizen. Applicants must be a Florida certified Law Enforcement Officer and be in good standing with their current employing Law Enforcement Agency. Applicants must submit a letter of good standing from their agency. All applicants must successfully complete a PBCC admissions application, the Corrections BAT (Basic Abilities Test).
