



Ability-to-Benefit Testing

Ability-to-benefit testing is required for a student who applies for Financial Aid, but cannot submit proof of either a high school diploma or a GED. In order to qualify for financial aid, the student must take the following sections of the College Placement Test (CPT): Reading Comprehension, Sentence Skills, and Arithmetic. Students who have already taken the CPT will be required to take and pass the Arithmetic section of the test before they can receive Federal Aid. If you are uncertain which sections you need to take, please see an Academic Advisor.
