

# Water or Wastewater Treatment Licensing



These non-credit continuing education courses prepare students for the Water and/or Wastewater Level "C" and "B" certification. Level "C" is offered in two parts of 80 hours each. Students must complete Part 1 before taking Part 2. Upon successful completion of both parts, students will receive a Certificate of Completion which will qualify them to sit for the "C" License exam.

An important segment of these courses provides operators information on overall plant operation and covers topics such as daily operating procedures, regulation of flows, chemical use and handling, records and reports, plant maintenance, emergency conditions and procedures, handling complaints, and energy conservation. The Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) has approved these PBCC continuing education courses.

## Water Treatment Plant Operation "B" License Level

At the Class B License level, emphasis is placed on troubleshooting water treatment plant process problems. The student-operator is expected to build on the knowledge gained from his/her treatment plant experience and the study material relevant to the Class C License level. A Class B student must have the ability to apply the skills learned in the Class C coursework, demonstrate basic problem solving skills and will develop an understanding of advanced water treatment techniques. The student-operator will be able to apply appropriate federal, state, and local regulations for the operation and maintenance of a public water facility.
