Application for Student Trustee 2009-10



In keeping with the College's commitment to student involvement, Palm Beach Community College (PBCC) has established a student position on the District Board of Trustees (DBOT). This position is non-voting and designed to ensure that student issues and concerns are represented. Students interested in serving in this capacity must apply for the position. To be considered, a student must meet the following criteria:

- Have a 3.0 cumulative GPA (Grade Point Average) or higher
- Have completed a minimum of 24 semester hours
- Be enrolled in a minimum of 9 hours in Fall/Spring semester during DBOT tenure
- Be available to serve in this position for the 2009-10 academic year
- Submit two letters of recommendation (from one faculty and one staff member)
- Write an essay titled "Why I want to be a Student Trustee" (*applicant's name and contact information must be included on the cover of the essay*).
