### Admission Requirements

To apply for the BAS program, students must have earned an AS/AAS or AA degree and have at least a 2.0 GPA. Students who have earned a minimum of 60 credit hours but do not have an associate's degree may apply on a provisional basis.

### Completion Requirements

Students must successfully complete all courses in the curriculum, have at a 2.0 GPA (at a minimum) and have earned a "C" or better in all general education courses.

### Program Length and Location

Total program credits: 120 (including transfer credits from the associate degree). The degree will be offered at the Lake Worth Campus.
